The International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) aims to ensure a skilled workforce capable of maintaining a safe and efficient air transportation system, through competency-based training and assessment. To support this, the Aviation Competency Management Service (ACMS) has been established. ACMS provides a consistent, comprehensive, and structured process for aviation professionals in Aerodrome Operations and Air Traffic Management (ATM) to evaluate and document their competencies.

This ensures all your personnel are competent in their role or highlights further training requirements to close gaps in knowledge, skills and experience.

The tool also helps organisations plan for those people with aspirations for further advancement within the aviation industry.

The variety and type of lighting systems depends on the volume and complexity of the aerodrome's operations. **Aeronautical Ground Lighting (AGL)** is standardized and it is essential all involved personnel are competent from design, installation & upgrading, to operations, inspection & maintenance.

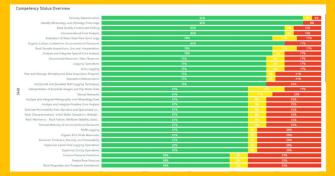
